



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for Cabin Crew Member Initial Training with ProffsAviation, selected Cabin Crew Member candidates must satisfy the following entry requirements (ref. to OPS 1 Subpart O):

- Minimum 18 years of age.
- Height between 157-185 cm.
- Has passed an initial medical examination (doctor's certificate) or assessment and is found medically fit to discharge the duties specified in the operations manual (Ref. also to AMC-OPS 1.1995).
- Remains medically fit to discharge the duties specified in the operations manual (Ref also to AMC-OPS 1.1995).
- Free from any physical or mental illness which might lead to incapacitation or inability to perform cabin crew duties (Ref also to AMC-OPS 1.1995).
- Normal cardiorespiratory function.
- Normal central nervous system.
- Adequate hearing.
- Normal function of ear, nose and throat.
- Language Skills according to Airline Operators specific requirements.
- Have adequate vision capabilities (at least 1.0 vision in both eyes with or without glasses, maximum lens correction +/- 3D).
- Graduation from upper secondary school education or equivalent education.
- Capability to swim 200 meters.
- A representative appearance, service minded, flexible, friendly, cooperative and communicative.
- Cope well in stressful situations.
- Capability to take responsibility.
- No notes on legal record.
